The University of Louisiana at Lafayette requires a core general education component of 42 hours. All students in the College of Engineering must satisfy this core in order to graduate. Students must earn 6 credits in non-remedial freshman English (or ESOL) with a "C" or better grade; a minimum of 6 credits in non-remedial mathematics with a "C" or better in the foundation course; a minimum of 9 credits in science, both biological and physical of which 6 credits must be selected in one area; a 3 credit communication elective; 9 credits in humanities of which 3 credits must be selected as a history, 3 credits must be selected as a literature, and 3 credits must be selected as directed by the department; and 3 credits must be selected from the area of the arts.

The core requires all students in the College of Engineering to earn 6 hours of credit in behavioral science (BHSC) electives. These include courses in the areas of ANTH, CJUS, ECON, GEOG, POLS, PSYC, and SOCI. The CHEE, CIVE, EECE, MCHE, and PETE departments require their majors to earn credit in ECON 430 while ITEC requires its majors to earn credit in ECON 300. CHEE, CIVE, and PETE majors may select the remaining 3 credits from the list of BHSC courses provided below. EECE and MCHE majors are restricted to select ECON 300 from this list and ITEC are majors are required to take PSYC 110.

Various programs in the College implement the remaining credits of the core differently. CHEE, EECE, ITEC, MCHE, and PETE require their majors to earn credit in ENGL 365 to satisfy the communication requirement while CIVE allows its majors to select a communication elective from the speech or English writing courses provided below. Finally, CHEE, EECE and MCHE require their majors to take PHIL 316 (PHIL 111, PHIL 314, or PHIL 316 for CIVE) while PETE requires its majors to select a second history or literature to satisfy the remaining 3 humanities credits.

The lists of courses below are electives which satisfy the UL Lafayette core. This list is periodically reviewed and approved by the Committee on Academic Affairs and Standards (CAAS). Any deviation from this list of courses must be approved in writing by the Dean's office before degree credit will be granted.
